***Edessa guyanensis* Fernandes & Doesburg, 2000, new record from Paraguay (Heteroptera: Pentatomidae)**

Abstract: Finds of *Edessa guyanensis* Fernandes & Doesburg, 2000 in two sites of Paraguay, far south of the previously known distribution area are given. A photograph in situ is added.

Resumen: Se reporta hallazgos de *Edessa guyanensis* Fernandes y Doesburg en dos sitios en Paraguay, 2000, muy al sur de su distribución conocida previamente. Se añade una fotografía in situ.

Zusammenfassung: Funde von *Edessa guyanensis* Fernandes & Doesburg, 2000 in zwei Lokalitäten in Paraguay, weit südlich der bisher bekannten Verbreitung werden mitgeteilt. Eine Photographie in situ wird beigegeben.

Key words: Paraguay, Pentatomidae, *Edessa*.

Introduction

The neotropical genus *Edessa* has “about 260 described species, but (estimation) at least 200 still undescribed!” (P. H. van Doesburg, 2011, in litt.). Many species of the genus *Edessa* occur in Paraguay, most of them differ only marginally from each other. These cannot be identified, nor can be described as new taxa because there is no revision of the entire species complex (Arnold, 2011). Few species-groups of the genus were revised or proposed by Fernandes et al. (2000a, 2000b, 2000c, 2001, 2011, 2012, 2014).

***Edessa guyanensis* Fernandes & Doesburg, 2000**

ALTO PARANA: Refugio Biológico Limoy, 24° 45' S 54° 27' W, 6. XI. 2006;
Estancia Dimas, 25° 32' S 55° 13' W, 7. VII. 2013.

E. guyanensis was first described in 2000, based on material from Suriname, French Guyana and Brazil (Fernandes & Doesburg, 2000). Other finds have been reported from Peru (Arnold, 2011). Additional occurrence can now be reported from two small remaining remnants of the former subtropical Atlantic forest in the eastern part of Paraguay.
